Of particular interest are those programs that will develop the skills and expertise that are relevant to the mining industry.

ENVIRONMENT

- To support programs and initiatives that protect Canada's natural habitat including but not limited to: conservation efforts, supporting the development of green and sustainable cities, protecting land, forests, water, and biodiversity.

WOMEN'S ISSUES

- To support programs and initiatives that provide help and services to marginalized girls and women including but not limited to: shelters, counseling, health services, support groups, training programs, child care, and programs designed to prevent gender based violence.

Additional Details:

- Barrick will consider projects that align with these three identified focus areas from Canadian organizations, with preference given to those who are working or have projects in the Greater Toronto Area.
- Only registered charities will be considered for funding.
- Funding requests should be for one year; if the applicant has received funds before, we are open to multi-year requests being made.
- Any organization that receives funding, must provide a final report on impact and outcomes achieved as well as a financial report showing how grant funds were spent. Final reports are required before being considered for renewed support.
- Barrick will not provide funds to support capital campaigns or advocacy campaigns.
